

CLIFF-TOP GORGE WALK

Our waymarked 3-mile round trip Cliff-top Gorge Walk takes about 2 hours and rewards walkers with the finest views in Somerset, including the karst limestone scenery of Britain's biggest Gorge, the chance to see our Primitive British Goats, also rare plants and animals, like Cheddar Pinks and Peregrine Falcons. There are some steep and rocky sections of path, so please wear walking shoes and suitable clothing, keep away from the cliff edges, do not feed the goats and follow the Country Code!



274 STEPS TO LOOKOUT TOWER & CLIFF-TOP WALK

Start at the 274 Steps

Finish at Lion Rock

Turn left & follow the road
Best route
Through gate
West Mendip Way
Black Rock Gate
Steep & muddy

Over stile
Stay outside the stock fence

Horseshoe Bend
Stock fence

High Rock (vertical cliffs)
Goat enclosure
Pulpit Rock
Lookout Tower

Right at marker post

Left over five bar gate

Over stile
